This area near Gid Lane has been grazed by sheep in winter as part of the maintenance plan. The meadow area has a diverse range of British native species and benefits from light weeding. Also paths need mowing in the meadow area for visitor access.

29th March	2pm-4pm	Mow paths and trim vegetation
19th April	2pm-4pm	Mow paths - weed and sycamore seedlings
10th May	2pm-4pm	Mow paths – pull horsetail weeds
24th May	10am-12	Mow paths - cut nettles, bullrush seedheads
Mow paths and weed as needed around 7th and 28th June.		
30th Aug	10am-12	Scythe selected areas of meadow
Sept To be arranged Thin reedmace, scythe, rake and remove cuttings		
27th Sept	10am-12	Erect sheep fencing
