(cut a few days previously by scythe)

THE WILDLIFE POND AREA

This area near Gid Lane has been grazed by sheep in winter as part of the maintenance plan. The meadow area has a diverse range of British native species and benefits from light weeding. Also paths need mowing in the meadow area for visitor access.

| Sept | To be arranged | Thin reedmace, scythe, rake and remove cuttings |
| 26th Sept | 10am-12 | Erect sheep fencing |
